

Thomas Streimelweger, born 1959, is an entrepreneur and investor in the IT and internet industry with focus on Emerging and Northern Europe. In 1987 he was a pioneer to establish S&T AG that became a market leader in computer services in the East Central European region (www.snt-world.com). Streimelweger managed S&T AG as the CEO until 2000. In 1998 he took the company public, however, remains its largest shareholder and non-executive chairman. To date, S&T with its headquarters in Vienna, operates subsidiaries in 23 countries in East Central Europe, Asia und the US employing approx. 3000 highly skilled IT experts and consultants.

In 2000 Streimelweger developed a major Central European Internet Company. Together with Siemens AG Österreich, he expanded the joint venture, red stars.com data AG into the markets of online software development, portals and online advertising. The global decline of the internet industry forced Streimelweger and Siemens to close this activity.

Today red-stars.com data AG, of which Streimelweger is the main shareholder and serves as CEO, is the holding company for a hedge fund group in the segment of statistical arbitrage/quantitative trading.

Streimelweger is also CEO and major shareholder of ST Global Holding AG.

Prior to founding of S&T, Streimelweger worked for Hewlett Packard, AWT/ Creditanstalt, Mannesmann Rexroth and Renault, mainly in trade and trade finance. He holds a degree in electrical engineering and graduated from Wiener Wirtschaftsuniversität.

Streimelweger is committed to charitable work. Most notably the Sovereign Military Order of Malta (www.orderofmalta.org), for which he served as a diplomat for seven years.
